St.Saviour's Church, Mount Abu.

The first church built in Mount Abu is the St Saviour's Anglican church {Church of England } it was also known as St Lawrence Church, it was built in the year 1834, This Church was built in the memory of Mrs. Elizabeth Smith the daughter of Mr. Lawrence it has some interesting stained glass windows, and carved wooden pews.

The total number of Christians in Abu are said to be less than 300 — no doubt the reason for the fact that there are only two churches in the entire area. The Christian Cemetery has interesting tombstones, some of the British soldiers are also buried in this cemetery the earliest being that of Col W. Andrews of the 51st Bengal National Infantry, who died on August 21, 1858, at 55.
